


PROJECT LOCATION & SITE MAP









During Construction:


 Temporary parking area to be modified to maximize surface parking, providing a minimum of 140 spaces. Parking area will remain in place until the garage is completed.

After Garage Construction is Completed:


- A minimum of 600 public parking spaces will be available in the garage.
- On-street parking will remain on 132nd St.
- 25,000 square feet of Community Space

After BBJ Facility Construction is Completed:

 In addition to the public garage, a minimum of 305 underground parking spaces will be provided for DOC staff.










QUEENS GARAGE AND COMMUNITY SPACE

CELLAR FLOOR PLAN









QUEENS CRIMINAL COURT - SOUTH FACADE



Community Construction Liaison





The Community Construction Liaison (CCL) will be located within or adjacent to the construction site in an office with ample space for community meetings around a conference table.

Community Liaison's Role:

- Endeavor to be the first point of contact for the community
- Be available and engaged with the community
- Manage expectations about the construction process by providing regular updates in advance of work operations
- Bring the communities concerns to the construction management team for review and resolution

Queens Borough Hall Municipal Parking Lot Soil Boring Operation

Work is scheduled to begin on Thursday March 18, 2021 and will last for approximately 4 weeks.

OUR WORK:

The NYC Department of Design & Construction is conducting a small boring operation at the current Queens Borough Hall Municipal Parking Lot to start the process of building a new garage as part of the Borough-Based Jails Program. This operation requires that a small drilling rig be set up within the lot. This will allow the drilling rig to bore a small diameter hole to test soil conditions. The operation will repeat itself in several predetermined areas for ground condition testing.

COMMUNITY IMPACTS:

Work is expected to begin on/about Thursday March 18, 2021 and last for approximately 4 weeks in duration. The effect on parking should be minimal. Each drilling/boring location will require the use of 3 parking spaces at a time. Work hours are Monday through Friday, 7am to 3:30pm.
