

## **Pedestrian Rerouting**

## On/about May 23<sup>rd</sup> to June 24<sup>th</sup>, on State Street bet. Boerum PI. & Smith St.

In preparation for the dismantling of the Brooklyn Detention Center, a new temporary Sally Port with Officers Booth will be installed on State St. Sidewalk modifications will result in rerouting pedestrian traffic as well as long-term elimination of 2 placard parking spaces on the north side of State St. and temporarily affecting 6 - 7 placard parking spaces on the south side of State St. Noise, pedestrian, and traffic flow impacts are expected during planned work.
