

## Planned for November 14<sup>th</sup>, 2023, at State St. and Smith St. intersection from 7:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.

Continuing with the dismantling of the Brooklyn Detention Center, preparation for the excavation of fuel tanks on the south side of State Street will commence. Delivery of new office trailers at the northeast section of the construction site by truck will take place. Traffic and pedestrian impacts at the intersection of State St. and Smith St. are expected. Signage and flaggers will direct pedestrians and vehicles as necessary.
