

## **Pedestrian Rerouting** On/about July 20<sup>th</sup> to July 22<sup>nd</sup>, on State Street bet. Boerum PI. & Smith St.

In preparation for the dismantling of the Brooklyn Detention Center, a new temporary Sally Port with Officers Booth will be installed on State St. Sidewalk modifications will result in concrete pouring on the north side of State St. temporarily affecting pedestrian egress along the existing temporary walkway. Pedestrians will be rerouted by flaggers as necessary. Noise, and pedestrian impacts are expected during planned work. Traffic flow will remain unaffected.
