4/8/24 - 4/9/24	7:00 am-9:00 pm (M - F) 9:00 am - 5:00 pm (Sat)	Brooklyn Detention Center (275 Atlantic Avenue)	North Yard Dismantling (Noise / Vibrations / Dismantling will commence by breaking the concrete deck with a demo hammer mounted to a track excavator / Noise will be like previous tower dismantle hammering activities)
4/8/24 - 4/10/24	7:00 am-9:00 pm (M - F) 9:00 am - 5:00 pm (Sat)	Brooklyn Detention Center (275 Atlantic Avenue)	Install Berm (Noise / Gravel will be trucked into the site and spread around the interior of the foundation using front-end loaders to prevent perimeter soil from shifting inward)
4/8/24 - 4/12/24	7:00 am-9:00 pm (M - F) 9:00 am - 5:00 pm (Sat)	Brooklyn Detention Center (275 Atlantic Avenue)	Remove Sidewalk Shed / Move Perimeter Fencing (Noise / Removal of sidewalk shed and pedestrian walkway on the west side of Smith St. between Atlantic Ave. and State St. / Perimeter fence will be moved back to the property line / Flaggers will direct vehicle and pedestrian traffic as necessary)
4/14/24	9:00 am – 5:00 pm	Brooklyn Detention Center (275 Atlantic Avenue)	Water Meter Removal on Atlantic Ave (Noise / Removal of water meter in the north lane of Atlantic Ave. / A section of the lane will be blocked to allow for the excavation and removal of the meter / Flaggers will direct vehicular traffic / AHV for Sunday work is at the direction of DOT and DOB. AHV was mandated for Sunday to avoid disruption of higher traffic flows on Monday – Saturday / No water interruptions are expected)
	Extended Work Hours: Mon – Fri: (7:00 am – 9:00 pm) Sat: (9:00 am – 5:00 pm)	*Site will shut down at 9:00 pm	



Handling a temporary water shutdown

The NYC Department of Design and Construction (DDC) installs and repairs the underground pipes that deliver water in New York City. Some pipes are over 100 years old and need to be replaced. New types of pipes are more resistant to cracks and breaks. They will safely deliver highquality water for decades to come. To do this essential work, we have to temporarily turn off your water.

Your water will be turned back on at the end of each work shift.

BEFORE THE WATER SHUTDOWN

- Store water for cooking, cleaning, and other needs
- Shut off the water main valve in your house or building to prevent plumbing problems, including brown water from sediments (or ask your landlord or super to do so)
- Turn off water-cooled systems such as central air and heating

ONCE THE WATER IS BACK ON

- •Turn on the building's water main valve (or ask your landlord or super to do so)
- Run all sink and tub faucets for 15-30 minutes to flush the plumbing
