In continuation with the construction of the new Brooklyn Detention Center, heavy machinery will be removed from the site. The machinery will leave the site through the Boerum PI. entrance with no expected major pedestrian or vehicular impacts. Noise is expected and flaggers will direct pedestrians and vehicles as necessary. DOT bridge crossing stipulations require late-night/early-morning removals. As such, this removal will take place at 5:00 am.
