Sidewalk Shed Removal

Planned for 7/18/24 through 7/25/24.

In continuation with the construction of the new Brooklyn Detention Center, pile drilling along Atlantic Ave. has finished and the sidewalk shed will now be removed. The north side of Atlantic Ave. will be closed during this work. Noise and pedestrian impacts are expected for this work. Flaggers will direct pedestrians to cross the street to the south side of Atlantic Ave. or to use Boerum Pl. or Smith St. for egress. Work will take place Mon – Fri. from 7:00 am – 6:00 pm and if needed, extending from 6:00 pm – 9:00 pm Mon – Fri and Saturday, 9:00 am – 5:00 pm.
