

Smith St. Temporary Vehicular Access Restrictions

Planned for Saturday, 5/31/25, 9 am – 5 pm.

In continuation with the construction of the new Brooklyn Borough-Based Jail Facility, Smith St. utility tie-ins are needed. In preparation for installing a new manhole at the corner of Smith St. and Atlantic Ave., test pitting is necessary to identify existing soil conditions. Most of the test pits work will be located inside the site perimeter with no public interaction.

One test pit will be drilled in the center lane of Smith St. TPC will create a temporary work zone for this activity and vehicle traffic will pass through the right lane. The Smith St. bike lane will remain open. Flaggers will direct pedestrian and vehicle traffic as necessary. Activities will be conducted within permitted hours.
