7/29/24 – 8/3/24	M-F / 7:00 am – 9:00 pm Sat / 9:00 am – 5:00 pm	(275 Atlantic Avenue)	Test pit drilling (Noise / Vibrations / Drilling within site perimeter to probe for previous site utilities / Minimal dust expected with mitigation practices to be employed)

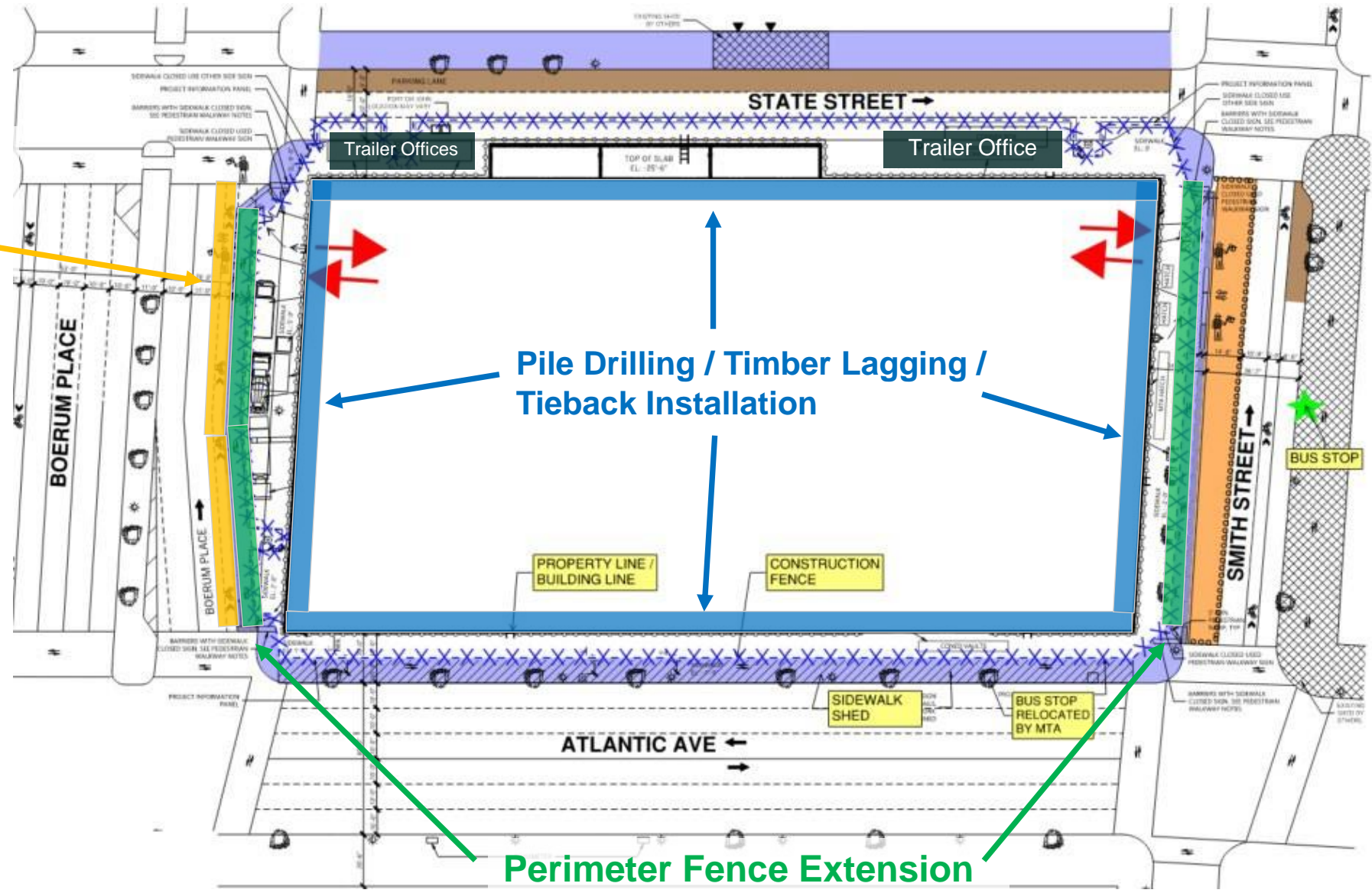
