

# Site Preparation and NYC Police Department Tow Pound removal to build Borough-Based Jail Facility

DDC is working with the Mayor's Office of Criminal Justice (MOCJ) and the NYC Department of Correction (DOC) to implement the City's plan to build four smaller, safer and fairer borough-based jail facilities and to close the jails on Rikers Island. This project will remove the NYPD Tow Pound and prepare the site for the construction of the future facility located at 745 East 141st St, including a complete environmental remediation of the site and the relocation/removal of the existing utilities.
