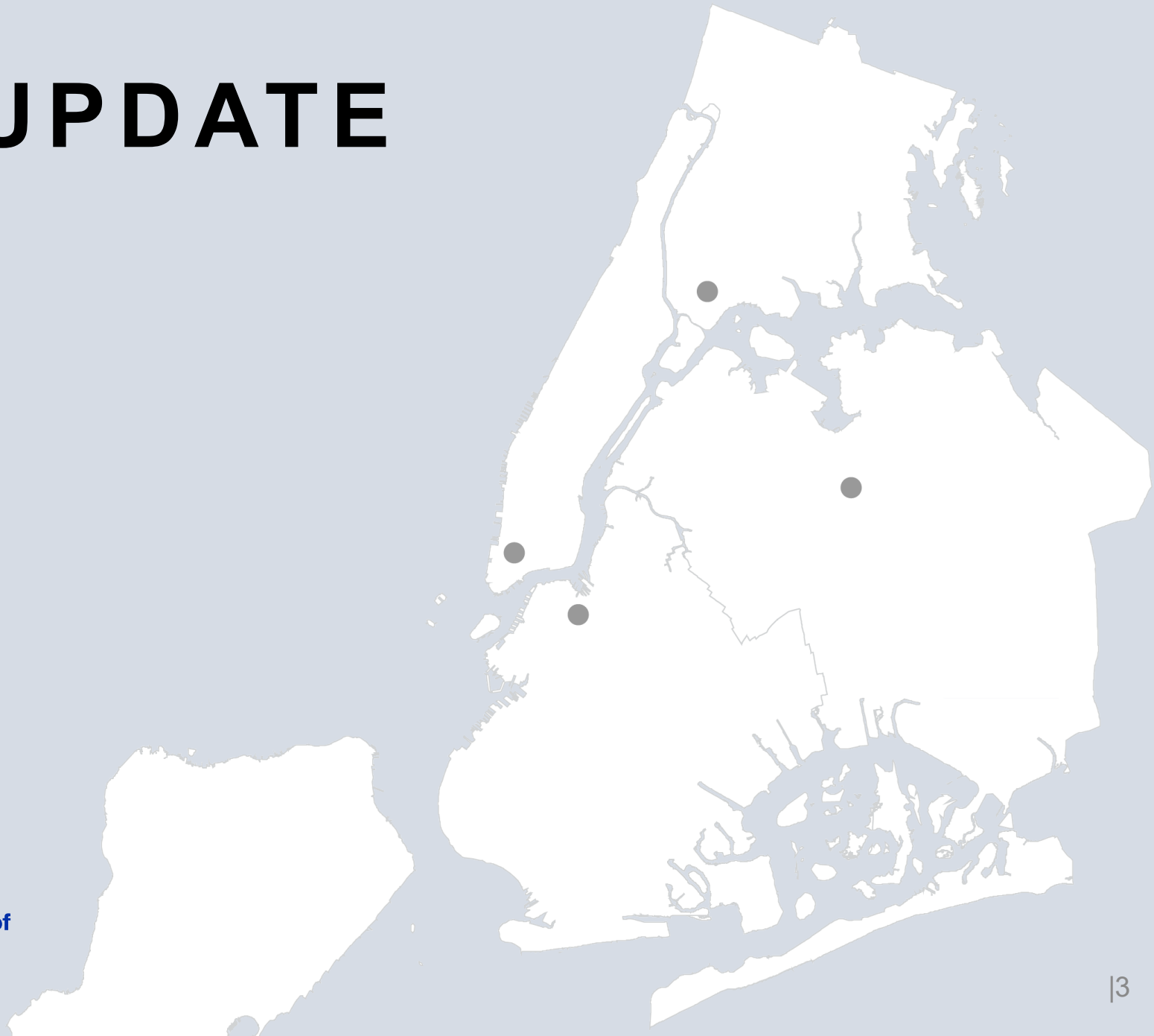

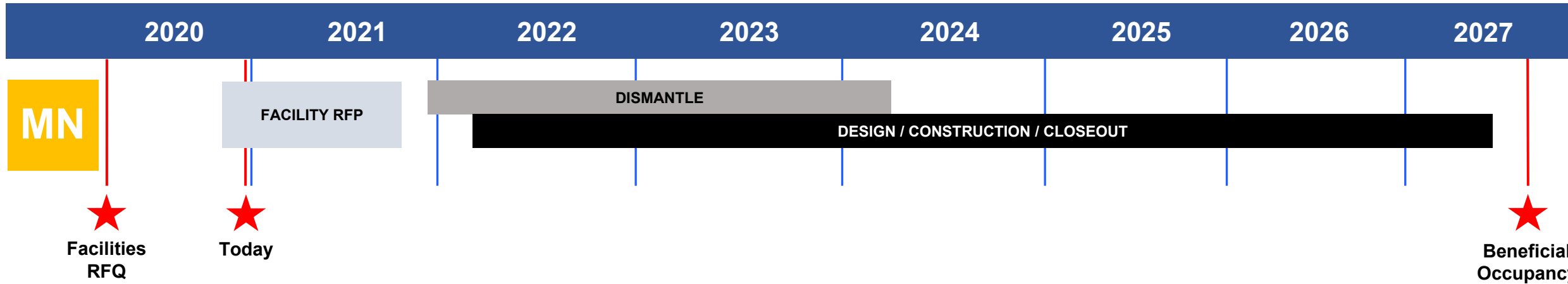

Recommendations for Design Guidelines

Seating Experience	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Formal seating: organized, clean, and structured• Accessible to disabled and elder people
Sidewalk Safety	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Hidden secured edge: accessible, attractive, and easy to maintain
Arcade Experience	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Gathering place, green: informal and softened by greenery, open natural feel, inviting, and low-key
Lighting Arcade Experience	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Ground lighting: creates openness in the space and allows it to function as a public space for community gatherings and people to meet
Facility Entry Identity	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Integrated entry: welcoming entrance scale, greenery• Distinct and recognizable shape: visitors can easily locate and identify
Street Level Experience	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Design should contribute to the community and be in alignment with the neighborhood character

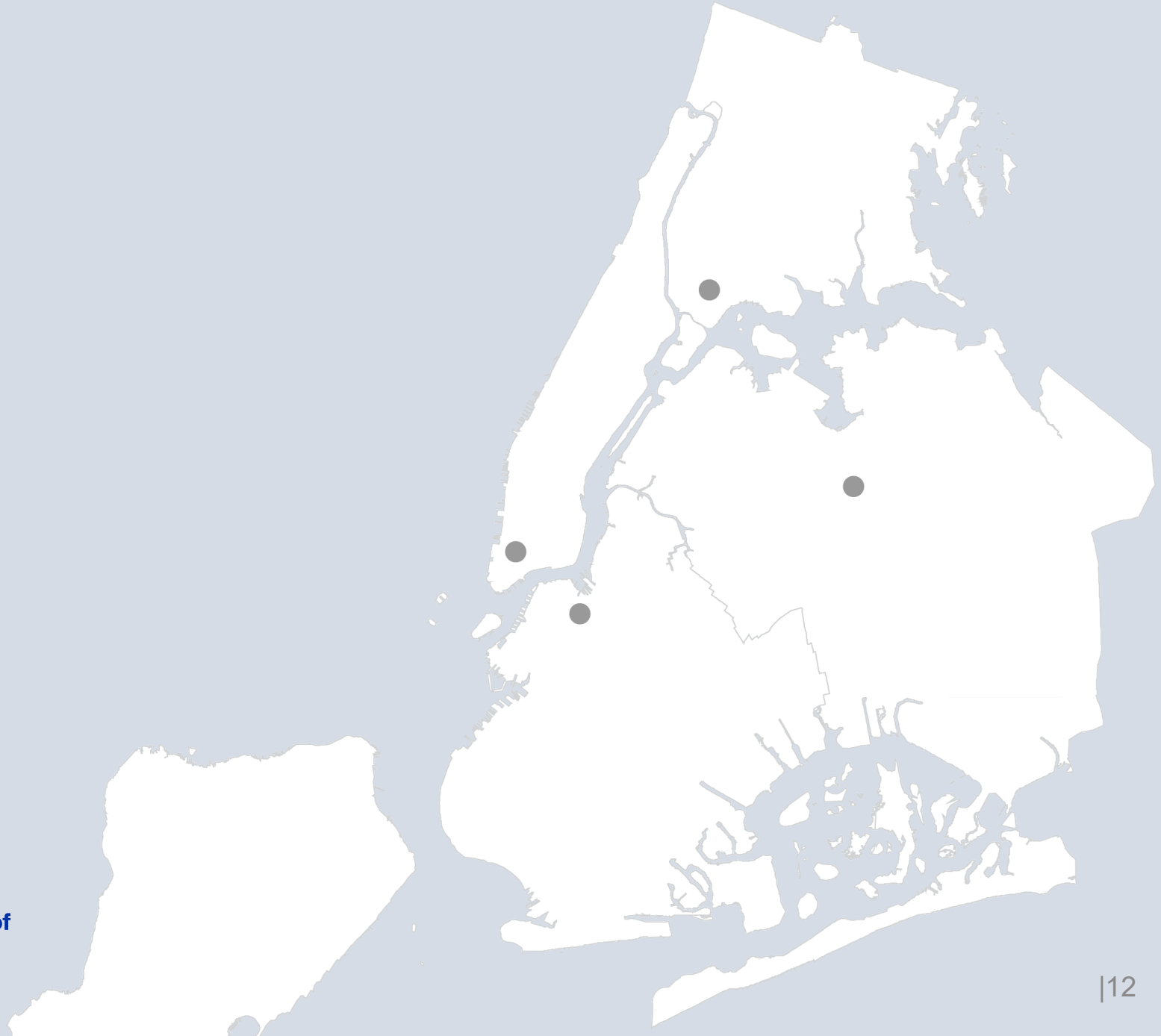
